Purpose

The NWCC Fall Kickball League is committed to providing a safe, fun, and family-oriented environment where every child can learn, compete, and grow. Every participant, parent, coach, official, volunteer, and spectator shares responsibility for creating a positive experience. Participation is a privilege and requires adherence to this Code of Conduct.

Player Code of Conduct

- Show good sportsmanship before, during, and after every game.
- Respect teammates, opponents, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators.
- Follow league rules and coach instructions.
- Encourage teammates with positive words and actions.
- Never use profanity, bullying, fighting, or intimidation.
- Care for league facilities and equipment.
- Play with honesty, integrity, and respect.

Parent & Guardian Code of Conduct

- Support all players and promote a positive environment.
- Allow coaches to coach and officials to officiate.
- Address concerns respectfully and privately after a 24-hour cooling-off period.
- Never use abusive language or threaten anyone.
- Do not coach from the sidelines.
- Help your child arrive prepared and on time.

Coach Code of Conduct

- Put player safety and development first.
- Treat every player fairly and respectfully.
- Model professionalism, honesty, and sportsmanship.
- Communicate openly with families.
- Respect officials and opposing teams.

Spectator Expectations

- Cheer positively for every child.
- Respect officials' decisions.
- Remain in designated spectator areas.
- Help create a family-friendly atmosphere.

Social Media Policy

- Do not bully, harass, or publicly embarrass league participants.
- Use social media to promote the league positively.
- The Board may discipline online conduct that negatively affects the league.
